

**查** 長夫婦李浩基和郭秋鳳四月二十九日休班期間在屯門一 **全**條公路上拯救一名七歲患有自閉症的迷途男童,相關影 片在網上廣傳,事件獲廣泛報道和讚賞。

兩人憶述:「我們當日下午駛往蝴蝶灣途中,在途經屯 門皇珠路連接龍富路時發現一名男童於車道間徘徊,險象橫 生。我們立即分工救人。」浩基在安全情況下停車,並以車身 阻擋部分行車線,避免後來的車輛收掣不及而發生意外;秋鳳 則跑向男童並帶他上車,再通知同袍提供支援。然而,男童一 直無法以言語表達意思,身上亦沒有親人的聯絡方法,兩人只 好讓值班同袍代為尋親。夫婦事後得悉男童因與家人爭執,憤 而離家出走並誤闖公路,幸好並無大礙。男童父親事後向兩人 送上親筆信,以示感激。育有一子一女的李氏夫婦表示,當天 雖在休假,但眼見男童身處險境,自己為人父母,必定不會袖

這已是二人加入警隊25年以來,第三次在休班期間滅罪 手旁觀。 和救人。第一次發生在二〇〇四年,他們到元朗參觀樓盤 時,在屋苑正門聽到有人大叫「搶劫」,兩夫婦立即追截疑犯, 並成功拘捕疑人。第二宗發生在二○○五年,秋鳳當時駐守失 蹤人口調查組,休班期間與丈夫在元朗逛街時,記起一名有精 神病紀錄的失蹤者愛於俊賢坊一帶流連,他們隨即到該處查 看,果然發現失蹤者,遂立即通知值班同袍到場接走事主。

對於屢次在休班時遇上突發事件,除巧 合外,李氏夫婦相信是與他們受過警隊的專 業訓練有關,故時刻留意身邊的人和事, 而身為警務人員均富有熱心助人的使命 感,不論在執勤或休班,只要發現有人需 要幫助,都會挺身而出,服務市民。

研討會提供良好的溝通平台, 讓參與者交流及分享在執法過程中 應用無人系統時遇到的困難和挑 戰,以及無人系統被犯罪分子濫用 的例子。與會者亦探討無人系統技 術的新發展、如何加強國際合作和 情報交流,以促進無人系統在執法 上的應用。





## Police Band performs in the Mainland



The Hong Kong Police Band (Police Band) was invited by the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Wuhan of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to perform in Wuhan, Taiyuan, Nanchang and Changsha between May 25 and June 5 to tie in with the Basic Law and Hong Kong National Security Law exhibition. The visit was the first time that the Police Band performed in the Mainland since the epidemic, telling good stories of the Hong Kong Police Force and demonstrating the Police Band's patriotism.

In addition to performing at the opening ceremony of the exhibition, the Police Band also held more than 20 concerts at different venues, as well as making marching performance in famous outdoor shopping streets. It even launched the "Music Touch" activity in the Mainland and had contacted more than 5 000 students. The Band members were arranged to visit the Wuhan Police Museum and tour monuments of the cities to gain a deeper understanding of the development of the national police force and the cultural heritage of our country.

# READ successfully held

The Recruitment Division (RECDIV) held the sixth Recruitment Experience and Assessment Day (READ) under the theme "Infinite Possibility" at the Hong Kong Police College on June 18 for participants to understand the recruitment selection process, training programmes at the Police College, and the diversified policing work through a series of activities, and to experience infinite possibility from policing work. The event attracted around 2 000 visits and 490 on-site applications.

The event consisted of three thematic sessions: (1) Selection workshops for Probationary Inspector / Police Constable; (2) Interactive Police Unit Display / Recruitment Talk / Sharing of Training Experience; and (3) Physical Fitness Test Workshops. Participants could submit application and undergo initial screening on the spot. Five Recruitment Spokepersons also shared information about the recruitment process with visitors. Moreover, it was the first occasion in which the Recruit Police Constable Chinese/English Written Examination was included during READ. Participants who successfully passed the written examination could be exempted from relevant assessment if they applied to join the Force within three months, and the results will be permanently valid.

The theme of the Interactive Police Unit Display tied in with the TV reality show *Profession Impossible* produced jointly by the Force and a TV broadcaster, and the Force's new promotional video *Guarding Our City with Faith - The Prequel.* Through the interactive show,



participants could experience in person the situations faced by frontline officers during daily patrol. Moreover, the number of participating units increased from six to eight this time. In addition, two cadres which participated in the shooting of *Profession Impossible*, namely the Police Negotiation Cadre and the Force Search Unit, joined the display for the first time.

In view of the overwhelming responses to the Physical Fitness Test Workshops in previous times, three sessions were held on June 17 and June 18. The READ workshops on application for Probationary Inspector / Police Constable and the thematic talks on the Force helped participants understand the recruitment and selection processes, as well as the skills for the tests.



## KE conducts **GT Exercise**

Kowloon East (KE) conducted a joint departmental counter terrorism (CT) exercise codenamed STRONGCARVER with the Fire Services Department (FSD) and Leisure and Cultural Services Department at Hong Kong Velodrome (HKV) at Tseung Kwan O on June 9. The exercise aimed to enhance the capabilities and coordination of the Force and other departments in handling terrorist attacks.

The exercise simulated a terrorist attack made by terrorists during an international sports event at HKV. Officers of KE's Emergency Unit and Police Tactical Unit, Tseung Kwan O District, Counter Terrorism Response Unit and Police

Participants of the exercise comprised over 350 persons, including members of Police Mentorship Programme, Project ACHIEVE, Mainland Alumni Association of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology and Senior Police Call. Prior to the exercise, officers of Interdepartmental Counter Terrorism Unit shared CT related information to participants to enhance the public's CT awareness.

## Workshops held for NTS frontline officers

Operations of New Territories South (OPS NTS) held workshops in the Districts within the Region between April and May to share skills for handling cases involving missing persons at risk and suspicious vehicles. In the workshops, Senior Superintendent of OPS NTS Chan Siu-ming reviewed the relevant tactical guidelines on handling suspicious vehicles. Officers were also invited to share their experience in handling suspicious vehicles for improving the efficacy of frontline law enforcement and the officers' safety awareness. Moreover, officers of Regional Missing Person Unit of NTS shared their techniques and experience in handling cases of missing persons at risk, as well as introducing Project L-Homecoming to frontline officers for better results in searching missing persons.

Furthermore, Chan Siu-ming took the opportunity to have in-depth communication with frontline officers at various levels to disseminate the latest strategic directions and understand their needs. NTS would keep strengthening communication and cooperation with frontline officers to enhance their professional capabilities continuously.

eputy Commissioner (Management) Chow Yat-ming (DCP MAN) was invited to attend the 16th Pearls in Policing

Conference held in Sydney, Australia between May 21 and 23. Participants of the Conference comprised 23 police chiefs and leaders from Asia Pacific, Europe, Middle East, North America, Australia and international organisations. Themed "Next-Generation Policing: The New Reality", the Conference focused on exploring the uncertainty and complexity of future policing. An academic forum, group discussions and peer-to-peer consultation were also held during the Conference.

DCP MAN, as keynote speaker of the session Dialogue with Police Leader, shared his valuable experience and how the Hong Kong Police Force (HKPF) faced the challenges during Operation TIDERIDER. He also had in-depth discussion and communication with the

digitalisation, human resources management and public engagement. DCP

participants on HKPF's strategic planning in MAN further took the opportunity to establish closer cooperation with the police chiefs and

leaders of various places.



Senior Superintendent of Cyber Security and Technology Crime Bureau Lam Cheuk-ho represented the Force to take part

in the International Action Learning Group (IALG) this year. At the start of the Conference, IALG made focused analysis on three major issues in policing, namely Next Generation Police Officer, Trust and Legitimacy, and Technological Advancement. # Another off-duty action by SGT couple

# **Autistic boy wandering** on highway saved

'he sergeant couple, Kay and Ann, saved a sevenyear-old autistic boy who had lost his way on an expressway in Tuen Mun while they were off-duty on April 29. The related footage has been widely circulated on the internet, earning wide media coverage and appreciation by the public.

The couple recalled, "We saw a boy wandering dangerously among the lanes at the junction of Wong Chu Road and Lung Fu Road on our drive to Butterfly Beach that afternoon. We immediately started rescuing the boy." Kay braked gradually and blocked part of the lanes with his car to avoid accidents being caused by the vehicles behind that might fail to stop in time. Ann dashed to the boy and brought him into the car. They then called their on-duty colleagues for help. However, the boy could not express himself in words all along; nor could Kay and Ann find any clues on the kid for contacting his family. All they could do was to ask their colleagues on duty to seek his family. It was learned afterwards that the boy had had a dispute with his family members. He then left home angrily and walked accidentally onto the highway. It was lucky that he was not injured. The boy's father subsequently wrote a letter to the couple to express his gratitude. As parents of a son and a daughter, the couple said they would certainly not watch as idle bystanders when they saw the boy in the dangerous situation, even though they were off-duty

This was the third time in their 25-year police career that the couple got into action while off-duty. The first incident happened in 2004. When they were touring an apartment with a real estate agent in Yuen Long, they heard someone at the main entrance of the housing estate yelling "robbery". The couple immediately chased the suspect and arrested him successfully. Another case happened in 2005. Ann was stationed in the Missing

Persons Unit then. When she was off-duty and went shopping with Kay in Yuen Long, it came to her mind that a missing person who had mental illness record liked hanging around Chun Yin Square. They indeed spotted the missing person there. Immediately they called the on-duty officers to pick him up

Kay and Ann believe that their multiple off-duty rescues are not merely coincidence. Thanks to the professional training from the Force, they pay special attention to the people and things around them. As police officers, they have a strong sense of mission to help others enthusiastically. No matter whether they are on duty or not, they will always come forward to help citizens in need
